Dear Parent/Carer

Further to our uniform consultation and whilst the uniform designs and arrangements for September 2026 are being finalised, I write to you with an update and reminders about the importance of our school uniform policy and our expectations for current students.

We have always placed a high level of importance on students wearing the school uniform in full and correctly as we believe that it plays a strong role in supporting a positive learning environment. Our uniform helps students develop a sense of belonging, reduces distractions, and promotes equality across the school community. When everyone follows the same expectations, it creates a calm, focused atmosphere where students can concentrate on their learning.

As we progress through the rest of this academic year, all students in Years 7 to 11 will be expected to continue to wear all items of school uniform each day. Please find below some guidance and reminders:

- At present, all students should be following the brown and yellow Uniform A or Uniform B as outlined on our [website here](#). Students wearing a skirt should be wearing brown tights or plain white or brown socks and black school shoes. Brown tights are available, black tights are not permitted, and tights should not be worn with socks.
- Many aspects of the school uniform are not changing and can be purchased from both uniform shops and at PSFA pre-loved uniform sales. This includes ALL items of the PE kit and the need to wear black school shoes (not boots or trainers) and a plain black or dark brown outdoor coat suitable for all weathers.

In September 2026, all of the new Year 7 students will be expected to wear the new uniform (themed around black and gold as previously communicated) and we will share designs of this once finalised. Whilst I imagine some current students will want to move to this new look, many may not want to, and they will be allowed to continue to wear the current uniform for as long as they wish and stocks allow.

We are aware that that the uniform suppliers are not replenishing the brown and yellow uniform stock. As this year progresses, if after checking with both of our school wear shops, and having attended the PSFA sale, you are unable to find an item of current uniform to fit then please contact

Very much later this year, stocks may get to the point where it is completely impossible to find a suitable size for your child and we are unable to help. If this is the case, we may begin to allow a mix (e.g. a white shirt in place of the yellow one). However, I will let you know when this is necessary. As you will have seen, there is another PSFA pre-loved uniform sale here at the School this Saturday 10-11am so please come along to pick up a bargain. Also, if you have items you can donate, please bring them to Reception.

Thank you for your continued support and for working with us to maintain high standards for all students.
