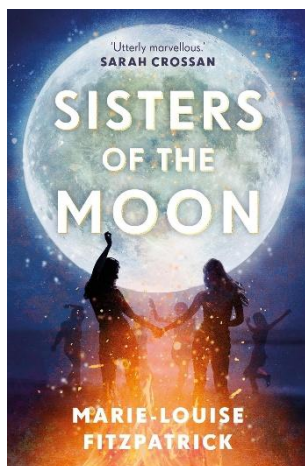

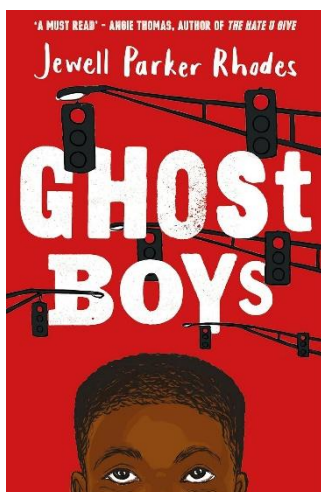

Sisters of the Moon, Marie-Louise Fitzpatrick

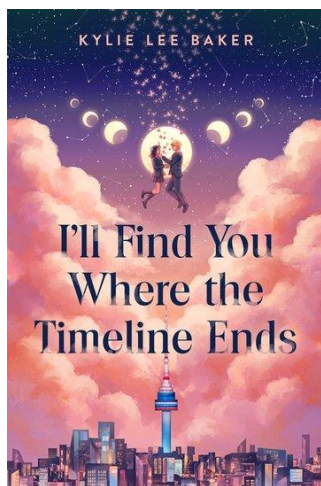
