The **Physics Summer School** is open to students aged 15–18. Please note that Part 2 requires at least one year of A Level Maths.

Course Dates: Part 1 (Classical Mechanics, Electromagnetism, and Astrophysics) will take place on the 10th – 12th August 2026.

Part 2 (Cosmology, Quantum Mechanics, Relativity, and Particle Physics) will take place on the 17th – 20th August 2026.

Teaching Hours: Each course runs from 10:00 am to 3:30 pm, including a lunch break.

Course Format: This is a live online event, held in small seminar groups for fully interactive discussions and problem-solving exercises. Sessions will not be recorded, so students must be available during course hours and have a reliable audio and video internet connection.

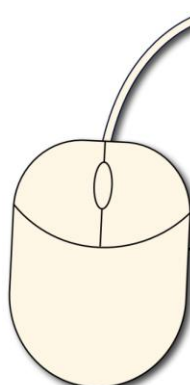

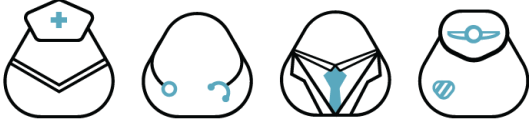
